### 60<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY VICAR'S TEA PARTY

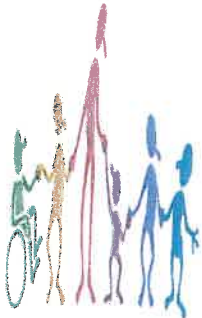

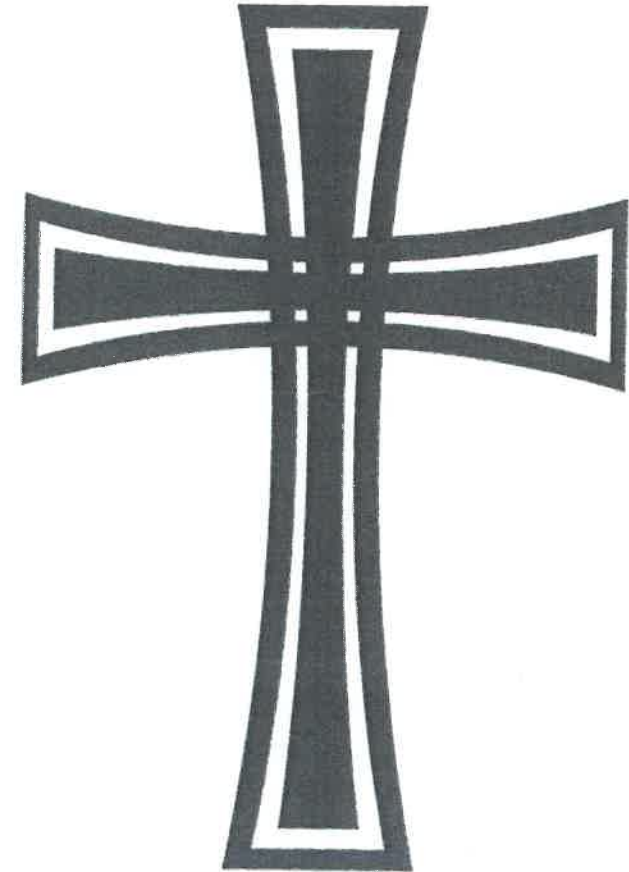
## OTHER EVENTS

### BASSALEG BARISTA

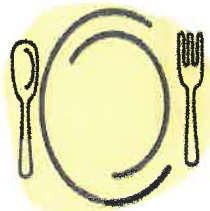
A warm welcome to Bassaleg pupils. FREE refreshments, FREE gaming. Open from 3.15pm every Thursday in the hall until the end of term.
